UFCW members from across the state will descend on the Michigan State Capitol on Wednesday, June 16 for the fourth annual UFCW Michigan Lobby Day.

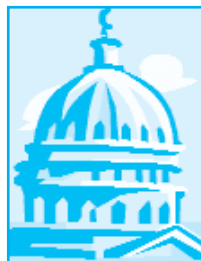
Participants will be briefed on current legislative issues important to workers and their
